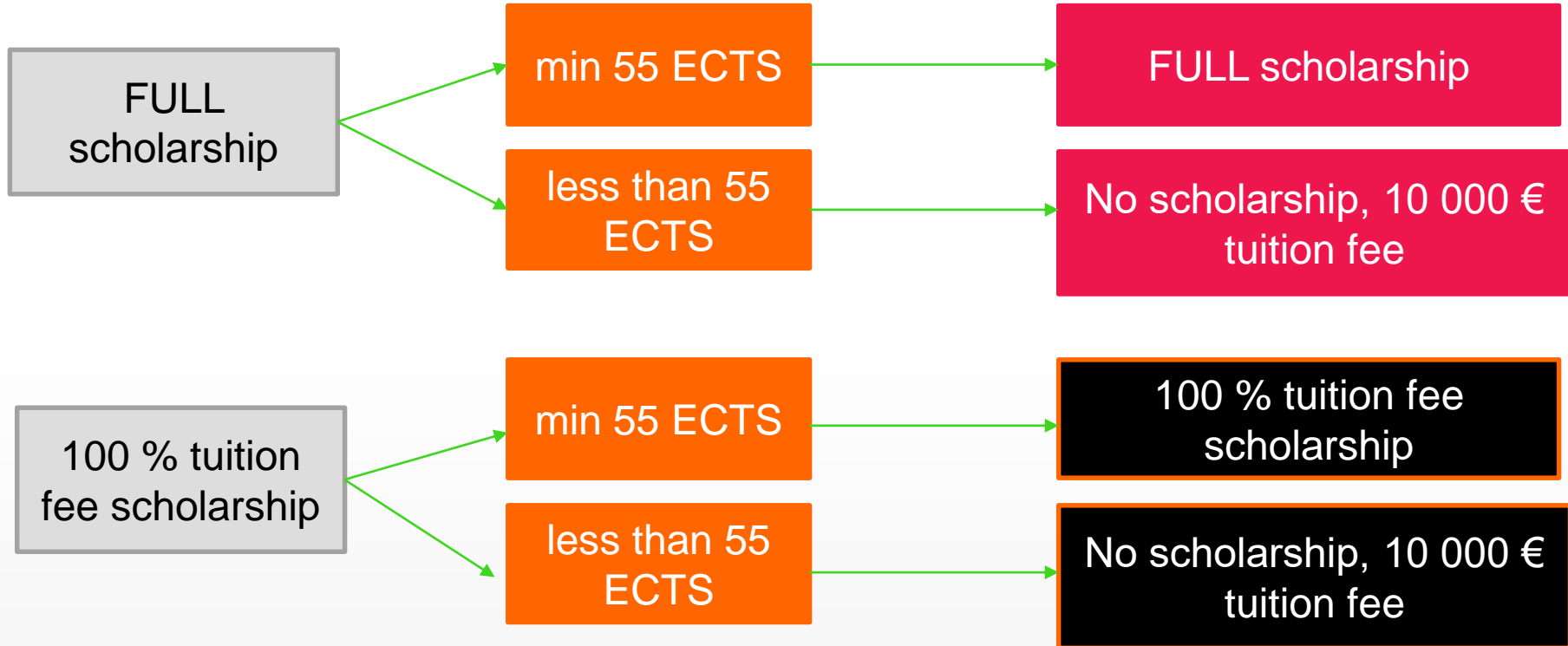

- Exchange student from non-EU country

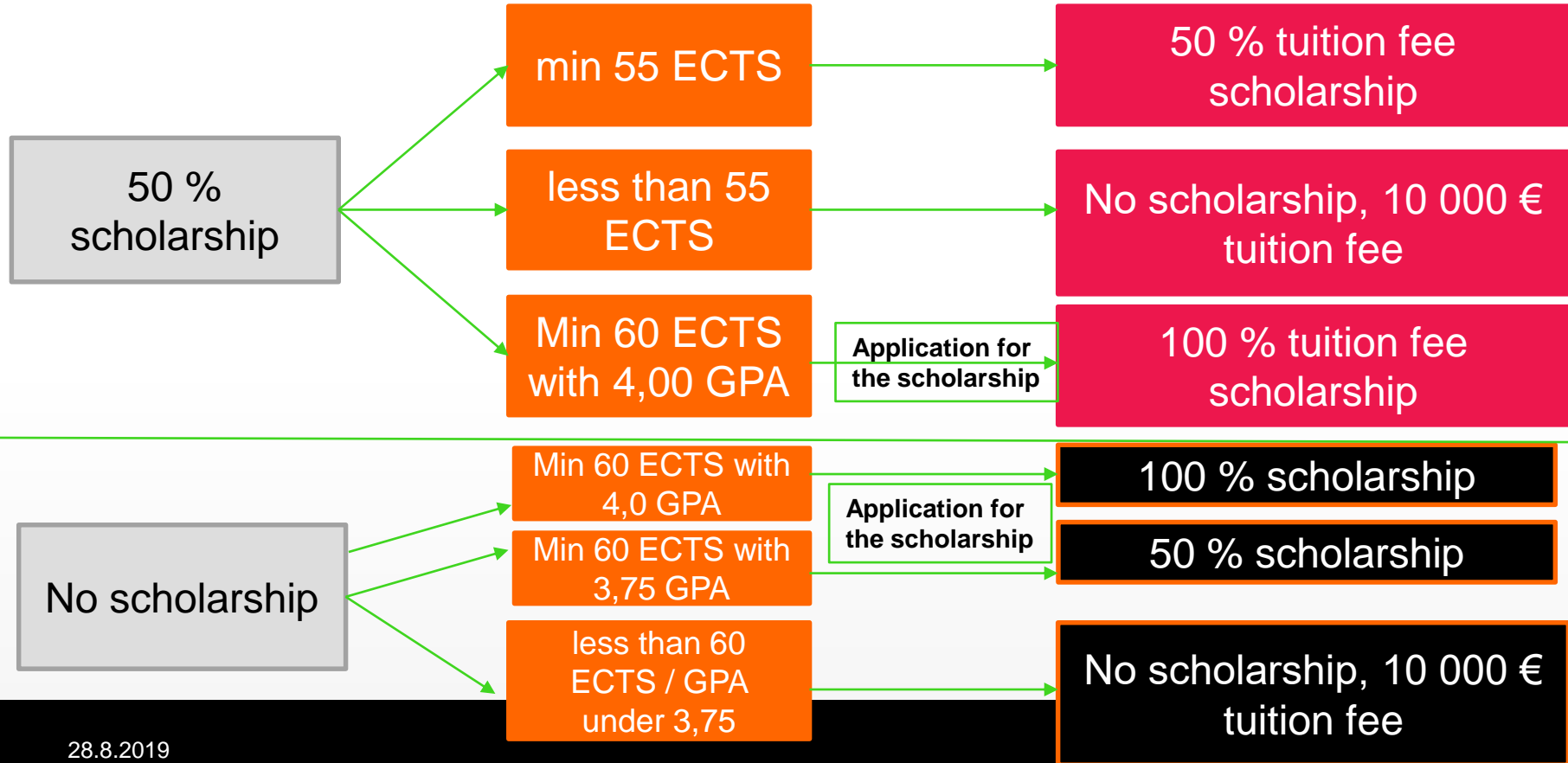
Tuition fee and scholarships for 1st year students

- Tuition fee 10 000 euros for all Master's degree programmes
- Three scholarship categories
 - **FULL scholarship** (covers tuition fees and living costs)
 - 1st living cost payment 30.9. or 15.10.
 - Need a Finnish bank account
 - **100 % tuition fee scholarship**
 - 10 000 euros tuition fee – 10 000 euros scholarship = 0 euros
 - **50 % tuition fee scholarship**

Remember to behave

- Lappeenranta University of Technology (LUT) may withdraw or terminate the scholarship if a student is in **breach of university regulations**, for example if the student practices plagiarism or commits other study-related offences. In addition, any other **misconduct leading to disciplinary measures** may result in the termination of the scholarship.

Things to know and remember

- According to the law all students who are citizens of a country outside the EU/EEA or Switzerland are required to pay the LUT tuition fee of EUR 10 000 per academic year. Only in case of the student having a certain type of Residence Permit card granted by the Finnish Immigration Service, the student is not required to pay the tuition fee.
- Credits for the second year scholarship must be achieved by 31 July 2020
→ **no exception!**
- Double Degree students will get a 1-year scholarship
- If you change your degree programme your scholarship will not automatically follow!
- **Maximum scholarship period for 2-year students is two academic years (4 semesters).**

Q&A

- *What happens if I have paid the tuition fee for the whole academic year but will graduate before the academic year is over?*
The remaining part for the tuition fee after the graduation date will be refunded to you based on a EUR/day calculation.
- *What if I have a LUT scholarship and I will not graduate on time?*
As a rule you have to pay tuition fee until you graduate. Note that you can not study (including working with your thesis) or graduate, if you are not able to pay the tuition fee.
- *I am going to complete a student exchange period or an internship abroad. Do I still have to pay the tuition fee?*
Yes, you do have to pay the tuition fee even if going for exchange studies or for an internship abroad.
- *What if my residence permit status changes (from fee paying to exempted from paying or from exempted from paying to fee paying)?*
The student is responsible for informing LUT of any changes in the residence permit.
